Play was in the Ottawa Senators zone and #18 (Clark Seymour) of the Cyclones was chasing for the puck. #18 reached forward for the puck and was slightly bent forwards with his head lowered. #12 (Kurt Gowdy) of the Senators, who had a significant size advantage over #18, threw a very hard body check into #18 of the Cyclones. This was not a high hit. The impact of the body check was to the left side of #18's head and his head was then crushed between the upper arm of #12 and the boards. #18 then fell to the ice and did not move. Play was stopped 5 seconds after this and all players were asked to leave the ice and stand in their respective benches.

An ambulance was called as this was a serious injury.

***Please Note: The initial penalty call as marked on the official game sheet was a Match penalty for Checking to the Head. After much consideration, it was determined that #12 of the Senators did not intend to injure #18. His intentions were to throw a hard body check, but did not intend it to be to the head of #18, and not an attempt to injure the player. The contact was severe, but accidental to #18's head. As such, I am changing my original penalty from a Match to a Major and a Game Misconduct for Checking to the Head.
